As per our previous conversations, The Salvation Army Center of Hope houses 35 veterans (or more) and all of our residents are required to find employment and housing within two years of residency. The Center of Hope participants receive mental health and substance abuse services while in the program and when they graduate, they are clean and sober and employed.

Many of our residents cannot afford to rent on their own and they are seeking a room-mate situation until they can save or increase their wages. Your housing opportunity sounds as if it will meet these needs.

I look forward to our continued relationship and the opportunity to refer our graduates to your safe, affordable two-bedroom units as soon as they are on line.
